## HOUSE WINES

### CHAMPAGNE

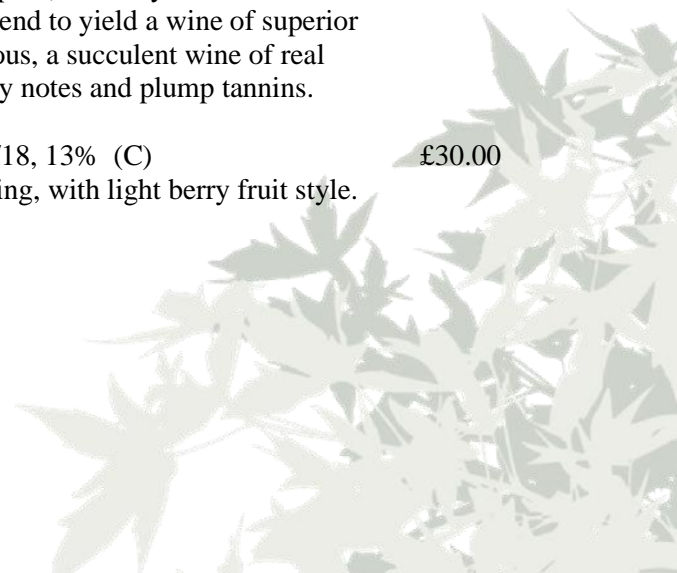
- 1 LOUIS DORNIER ET FILS, BRUT, NV, 12% (1) £45.00  
A stylish Champagne with a pronounced biscuity flavour. A fine elegant, bouquet, the result of fine blending and good bottle maturation.

### WHITE

- 5 VINE TRAIL VIOGNIER, RAPEL VALLEY, CHILE, 2019/20, 13% (2) £24.50  
Made from 100% Viognier, this wine shows notes of peach, apricot, pear and white blossom, balanced with a citrus acidity on the palate.
- 8 DASHWOOD CHARDONNAY, MALBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND, 2018/2019, 14% (1) £30.00  
Careful winemaking, specific yeast strains and subtle use of oak are used to enhance the vibrant fruit flavours: night harvesting was also employed to retain flavour and freshness. Good palate weight with ripe peachy flavours; elegant and well-balanced peach, pear, pineapple and red apple with a hint of vanilla and toast.

### RED

- 13 THE GUV’NOR, GRENACHE/TEMPRANILLO, FELIX SOLIS, SPAIN, NV, 14% (D) £26.50  
The grapes for The Guv’nor come from a number of regions including Toro, La Mancha and Valdepeñas; the blend is predominantly Grenache with the balance Tempranillo. Made to a fruit-driven style it shows notes of vanilla from a short period of oak ageing. This is a no-nonsense wine, which shows plenty of rich, ripe, sweet red and dark fruit flavours and a juicy finish.
- 14 TRIVENTO RESERVE MALBEC, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA, 2018/19, 13% (C) £26.00  
Using equal quantities of Malbec grapes from Luján de Cuyo and Uco Valley, the hand-harvested grapes are crushed and macerated prior to fermentation in stainless steel; the wine is aged in French oak barrels for six months. Aromas of plum and raspberry dominate with notes of vanilla; the palate is velvety to the finish with fleshy, ripe fruit and a note of spice.
- 15 BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGES COMBE AUX JACQUES, LOUIS JADOT, FRANCE, 2017/18, 12.5% (B) £35.00  
To enhance the quality of the wine, Louis Jadot practices a ‘replis’, whereby wines from various Crus of Beaujolais are declassified and added to the blend to yield a wine of superior structure, depth and complexity. Intensely fragrant and vivacious, a succulent wine of real charm, full of bright floral fruit flavours, with youthful peppery notes and plump tannins.
- 16 CÔTES DU RHÔNE, AUGUSTE BESSAC, FRANCE, 2017/18, 13% (C) £30.00  
Young and well-ripened this Rhône is wonderfully easy-drinking, with light berry fruit style.

- O1 SAUVIGNON BLANC, WILD THING, SPAIN, 2018/19, 12% (2) £28.00  
Fresh, lively and uplifting dry white from the arid La Mancha region. Its rich fruit flavours and balancing acidity make for a delicious and versatile drinking experience. Suitable for Vegetarians and Vegans.
- O6 VIRE CLEESE HARMONIE, DOMAINE VERPAILLES, BURGUNDY, FRANCE, 2017/18 £39.00  
 **LS** Arguably the top “cru” of the Maçon, and one of the best value regions in all of Burgundy. This offers all the richness and complexity of much more names (Puligny-Montrachet et al) but at a fraction of the cost.
- O7 HOOPOE PINOT GRIGIO/CATARATTO, SICILY, ITALY, 2018/19 **LS** £29.00  
A Sicilian white bursting with ripe peach and apple flavours. Luscious and soft, yet with a maritime freshness typical of island wine. Great with a range of food, or just as a treat on its own !

#### ROSÉ

- O5 ROSÉ DE LÉOUBE, CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE, 2019/20, 12.5% (2) £42.00  
A beautiful wine that really shows its sea influences. Its slightly floral and citrus aromas help keep that summer feeling alive. Romain Ott, Léoube’s head winemaker and alchemist is adamant you should drink it all year round as a perfect dinner party wine, as an aperitif or with seafood.

#### RED

- O3 CHÂTEAU ROCHECOLOMBE, CÔTE DU RHÔNE, FRANCE, AOC, 2018/19, 14% (C) £30.00  
**LS** A fantastic nose of spice and strawberry is the first sign that you’re onto a fantastic example of Rhône. Full of black fruit flavours, peppered with delicious spicy elements and wonderful aromas of liquorice and herbs.
- O4 MALBEC RESERVA, DOMAINE JEAN BOUSQUET, ARGENTINA, 2018/19, 14.5% (D) £34.00  
An opulent, powerful Argentinian Malbec with robust blackberry richness infused with dark chocolate and spicy oak make for an impressive red that might be overwhelming if it weren't for the damsony acidity derived from its high altitude vineyards of Tupungato in Mendoza's Uco Valley.
- O8 PIQUERAS HIGH ALTITUDE GARNACHA TINTORERA, ALMANSA, SPAIN, 2017/18 £28.00  
Rich and full-bodied red wine with an extensive range of ripe dark fruit and wild fresh herbs. Smooth juicy tannins and good levels of natural acidity combine to offer a wine full of flavour and character
- O9 IGP PAYS D’OC CUVÉE SECRETE MERLOT/CABERNET FRANC, LANGUEDOC, FRANCE, £29.00  
2018/19 **NS** Stunning “no added sulphur” wine from Paul Mas in the Languedoc. 60% Merlot and 40% Cabernet Franc, this captured the warmth of the southern-French sunshine in the juicy black fruit flavours and the herbal/spicy finish is nicely appetising.

#### PROSECCO

- O10 GIOL PROSECCO SPUMANTE EXTRA DRY, VENETO, ITALY, NV, £34.00  
A delicate nose with aromas of straw, white flowers and peachy fruit. The mouth has a lovely balance of fresh leaf and fleshy fruit flavours. A great example of how hood Viognier can be.



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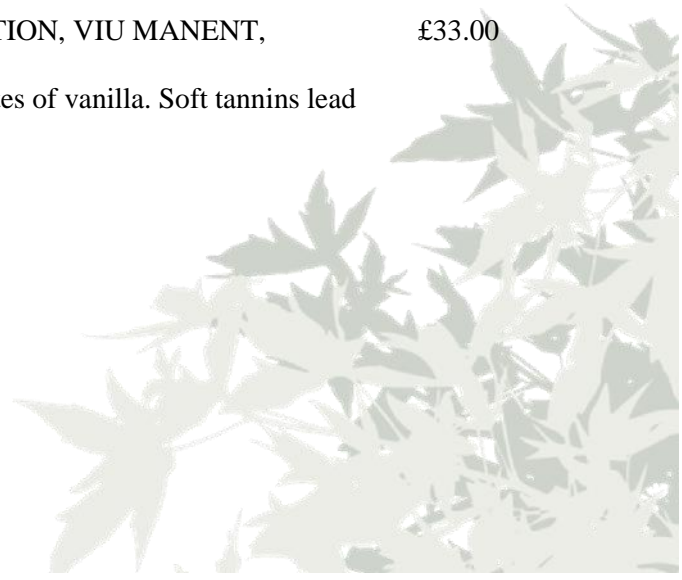

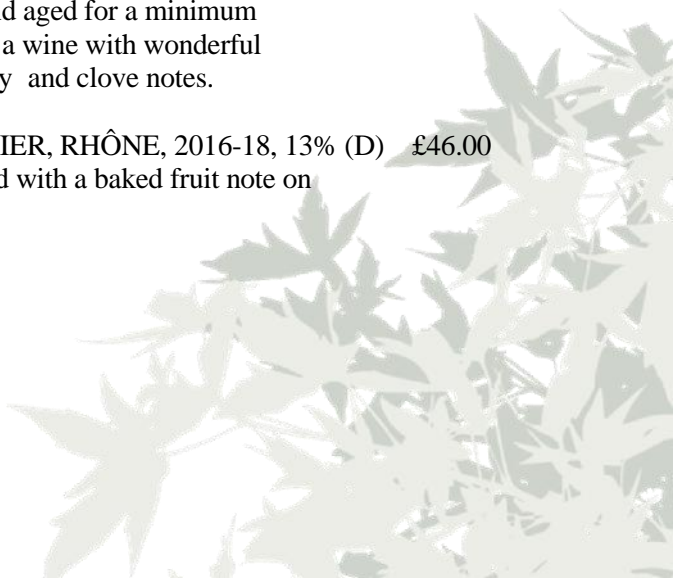

Produced from predominantly Merlot grapes which suit the light gravel and sand soils of Lalande. It is accompanied by Cabernet Sauvignon for its great aging potential and Cabernet Franc for its structure and its rich bouquet. The palate is full and balanced with notes of blackberry jam and caramel.
- 41 CHÂTEAU CITRAN, HAUT-MÉDOC, 2010, 13.5% (D) £60.00  
Back at the height of its game with richer and more virile styled wines. Liquorice and hedgerow fruits encompass an open round personality, both great value and very satisfying.
- 42 CHÂTEAU DE PEZ, CRU BOURGEOIS EXCEPTIONNEL, ST ESTÈPHE, 2008-15, 14% (D) £85.00  
Intensely deep colour, it has the cassis and tobacco leaf nose of ripe concentrated Cabernet from this classic area. Big, fine flavours, richly austere, maturing at a dignified pace with real elegance.

### RED BURGUNDY & BEAUJOLAIS

- 43 CAVES DES GRANDS VINS DE FLEURIE, BEAUJOLAIS, 2018-20, 13% (B) £34.00  
This wine, arrayed in a deep garnet hue flecked with purple, offers up a powerful black fruit bouquet. Notes of slightly tart blackberries give this wine a nice balance. On the palate, the powerful, smooth tannins reinforce the succulent character of this Fleurie, which delivers a lovely, long-lingering finish.
- 44 HAUTES CÔTES DE BEAUNE, DOMAINE CHANSON, 2012-16, 12% (C) £56.00  
True Burgundy quality has been given to this young Hautes Côtes- a real over-performer in its class with vibrant fruit and absolute depth.
- 45 NUITS-ST-GEORGES, LOUIS LATOUR, BURGUNDY, 2010-16, 13.5% (C) £120.00  
Ripe cassis and black cherry fruit aromas. Classic vegetal, mushroomy character with long, elegant finish showing a rich vanilla flavour.

### RED RHÔNE

- 52 SAINT JOSEPH, COLOMBO & FILLE, RHÔNE, 2013-18, 13% (D) £50.00  
From hand-harvested Syrah, this wine is traditionally vinified and aged for a minimum of twelve months in a mixture of old and new oak. The result is a wine with wonderful richness and a dense full-bodied structure with blackberry, cherry and clove notes.
- 53 CROZES HERMITAGE, LA PETITE RUCHE, M. CHAPOUTIER, RHÔNE, 2016-18, 13% (D) £46.00  
Red fruits, blackcurrant and raspberry aromas, fresh and rounded with a baked fruit note on the palate. Very fine and elegant.



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## SOUTH OF FRANCE

- 57 PINOT NOIR VALMOISSINE, LOUIS LATOUR, CÔTEAUX DE VERDON, 2016-19, 12% (B) £36.00  
Valmoissine is the upland site of an ancient monastery, perfect for quality Pinot Noir. The proof is in the wine with its fresh strawberry aroma and open flavours. The effect is of ripe softness.


## ITALY

- 64 APPASSIMENTO, CASA VINIRONIA, PUGLIA, 2016-19, 14.5% (D) £25.00  
A full-bodied soft wine giving characteristic notes of plum and raisins. Oak ageing adds to the intensity with pleasing notes of spice and vanilla.

## NEW ZEALAND

- 69 MERLOT-CABERNET-MALBEC, ESK VALLEY, HAWKES BAY, 2011-19, 14% (D) £48.00  
Full dark red colour. Soft Merlot, firm Cabernet and dark Malbec come together perfectly in this smooth integrated blend.
- 70 PINOT NOIR, THE CROSSINGS, MARLBOROUGH, 2015-19, 13.5% (B) £40.00  
Finely poised aromas of red cherry, spice, raspberry and gentle smokiness. The palate is vibrantly intense with a full, rich and silky mouthful.

## PORTUGAL

- 82 RIOJA CRIANZA, CORMORAN, RIOJA, 2016-19, 14% (C) £28.00  
Dark cherry red. Clean with intense ripe fruit, liquorice and toasted notes. This wine is rich and rounded in the mouth with a lovely long finish.
- 83 RIOJA RESERVA, ERMITA DE SAN FELICES, BODEGAS SANTALBA 2012-18, 14% (D) £42.00  
Intensely concentrated with masses of ripe blackberry fruit and wonderful enriching sweetness. Beginning to show meaty, gamey, leathery development with a finish that lasts forever. Fabulous!

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## U.S.A. – CALIFORNIA

- 87 HAHN WINERY, PINOT NOIR 2018-20, 14.5% (C)  £45.00  
This wine's bouquet charms with scents of red cherry, ripe strawberry, cola and spice. On the palate, soft mouthfeel complements flavours recalling plums and black cherry. Supple tannins and a dash of acidity end in a beautifully balanced, clean finish.

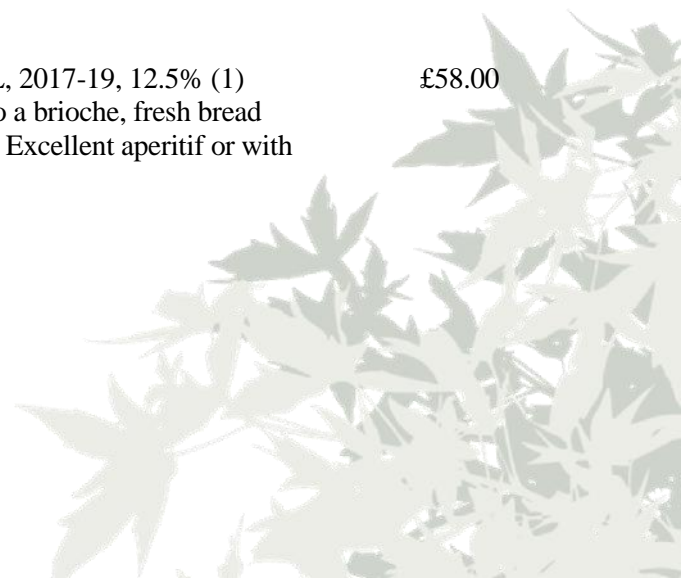
