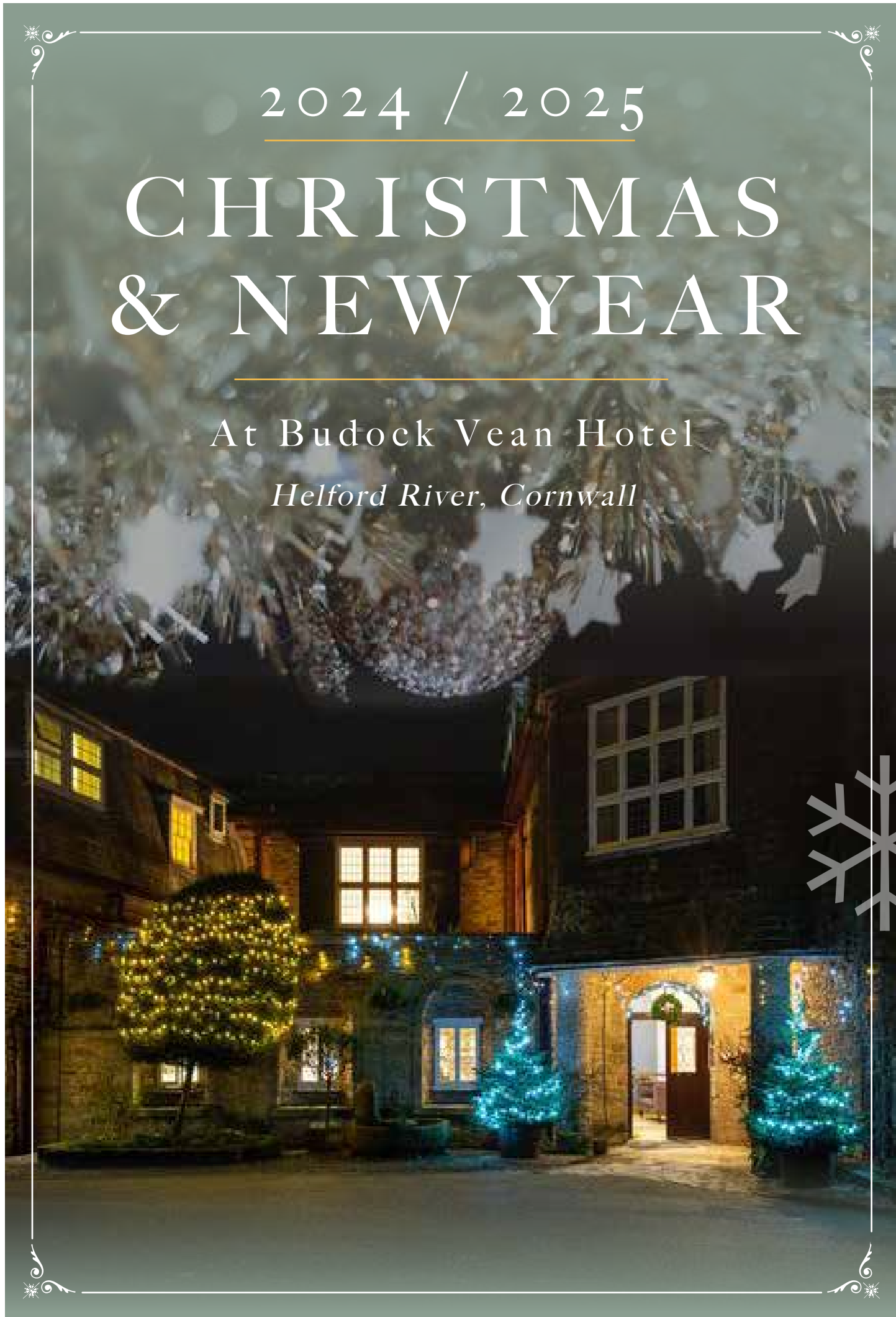

FREE DAY IDEAS

There is so much to see and do in and around Budock Vean. Here are a few ideas to whet your appetite.

Local Visits: **Trebah Garden** is a short walk from the hotel as is the **Ferry Boat Inn**, the river side pub. The family friendly **Seal Sanctuary** is around the corner in the village of Gweek and the **National Maritime Museum Cornwall** and **English Heritage's Pendennis Castle** are both in the harbour town of Falmouth, about a 15 minute drive.

A little further afield **National Trust** properties **Trelissick** and **St Michael's Mount** make for a lovely visit; perhaps take a trip to the dramatic north coast to watch the surfers or down to **The Lizard** and the southern most tip of England. If you need any tips please do ask

Local Walks: We're spoilt for walks around the Helford, you'll have no trouble getting in your 10,000 steps and the views are incredible.
